## HOW TO PREPARE

<p><u>Clear, Brown, and Green Glass</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Jars and bottles only.</li> <li>• No light bulbs, safety glass, mirrors, china, ceramics, or window glass.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Remove plastic caps.</li> <li>• Rinse clean</li> <li>• Sort by color and place in appropriate container.</li> <li>• Do not place any bags in glass containers.</li> </ul>
<p><u>Plastic</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Type 1 &amp; 2 plastics only.</li> <li>• Look for the numbers on the bottom of the containers.</li> <li>• No motor oil, pesticide, or herbicide containers.</li> <li>• The bottle openings have to be threaded and smaller than the base or widest part.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Remove plastic caps and discard.</li> <li>• Empty and rinse.</li> <li>• Do not need to remove the labels</li> </ul>
<p><u>Steel, Tin, Aerosol, and Aluminum Cans</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All steel, bi-metal, and aluminum cans and lids.</li> <li>• Empty paint cans (1 gallon or less).</li> <li>• Empty aerosol cans (non-pesticide).</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Rinse can out.</li> <li>• Remove plastic caps from aerosols.</li> <li>• Empty metal cans only.</li> <li>• No sheet metal, pots &amp; pans, or nails</li> </ul>
<p><u>Mixed Paper</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Egg Cartons, paper bags, dry food boxes, junk mail, and office paper.</li> <li>• Soda &amp; beer boxes.</li> <li>• Hard and soft cover books.</li> <li>• No juice or other beverage containers.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Paper must be dry and free from residue.</li> <li>• Place in container loose.</li> <li>• Flatten all paper boxes.</li> <li>• Remove plastic liners from paper materials.</li> </ul>
<p><u>Newspaper</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Newspaper, catalogues, and magazines.</li> <li>• Newspaper inserts and adds.</li> <li>• No paper bags.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Paper must be dry and free from residue.</li> <li>• Place in container loose.</li> </ul>
<p><u>Corrugated Cardboard</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Corrugated boxes only.</li> <li>• No paper juice, beverage containers, or pizza boxes.</li> <li>• No soda or beer cases.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cardboard must be dry and free of residue.</li> <li>• Flatten all boxes to conserve space.</li> <li>• Cut down boxes to smaller than 3 ft. x 3 ft.</li> </ul>
